We focused on letters Ff and Jj. Our "Franny the Fan" and "Jump rope" sound cards will help us remember the sounds these letters make. We added for and am to the word wall and reviewed our previously learned sight words. In writing workshop, we focused on what makes writing easy to read. We need to use spaces between our words, write lots of letters for the sounds we hear in longer words, not use too much eraser, etc. We also talked about how to get more creative with our story titles. Instead of "Over the Weekend," we might title our work, "Adventure at the Park".

This Week in Math:

We counted objects and focused on identifying more than and less than. We also reviewed our flat shapes!

This Week in Science:

We learned about winter. We talked about how the weather changes during this season and what people and animals do during this time of year. We learned words like blizzard, migrate, hibernate, and dormant. (We talked about how trees are dormant in winter.)
