This Week in FLA:

We did lots of letter sound review, letter blending, and perfecting our handwriting for learned letters (Ss, Mm, Pp, Dd, Aa). In independent reading, we continued talking about super powers of reading. We added picture power and sound power! When we get a tricky word, we can focus on the first letter, think of the sound it makes, and then check the picture for something that starts with that sound. In writing workshop, we are wrapping up our true story writing. This Week in Math:

We practiced the concept of one less. We looked at a number line and practiced hopping our frog back one number. We crossed out objects and said, "__ is one less than ."
