This Week in ELA:

We focused on letters Vv and Yy. Our "Vinnie the Vacuum" and "Yolanda the Yak" sound cards will help us remember the sounds these letters make. We also added *was* and *were* to the word wall. In independent reading, we learned that readers ask these questions when they get to an unknown word and make a guess: *Does it look right? Does it sound right?* In writing workshop, we continued our How-To Writing. We discussed how writers use punctuation marks and spell words correctly using our 'word wall' words. We also discussed how important it is to use *specific* words and pictures to help our readers understand. Your reader should know exactly what to do by the words you choose to write.

This Week in Math:

We are still working with adding using pictures, objects, number bonds, number sentences and number stories. We use 2 different colored 5 cube sticks to visually see partners used to make 6, 7, and 8. For example partners to make 6: 1 and 5, 2 and 4, 3 and 3.



This Week in Social Studies:

We discussed two African Americans that have changed the world through their words: Rosa Parks and Ruby Bridges. We learned that they helped make the world a better place and believed all people should be treated fairly, no matter their skin color.

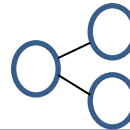
