This Week in ELA:

We focused on the sounds of long Oo and short Oo. We know mop is a short Oo word like "Bob the Fox" but mope is a long Oo word because the Oo "says its name" in the word. We also added little, do, she and there to the word wall. In writing workshop, we continued to write about something we know how to do. This week, we focused on concluding our stories. Our endings should "wrap up" what the book was about and invite readers to try out what we taught them!

This Week in Math:

We continued discussing subtraction. We know we take away from the whole number in a subtraction problem. We also know that the number that follows the minus sign should match how many objects we cross out. It is easy to confuse which number sentence matches the picture:

0000 4-3=1 OR 4-1=3

Your student learned about the International Space Station and space shuttles. They learned how these shuttles are powered, what types of activities astronauts do on them, and had a hand in building a shuttle of their own.
