This Week in ELA:

We focused on letters Uu, Vv, Ww, Xx, Yy, and Zz. We identified the letters, noticed the straight and curved lines that help form them, and talked a little bit about their sounds. We identified sight words *he* and *had*. We also read and acted out *Humpty Dumpty*. In independent reading, we focused on storybooks. It was so fun to introduce some of our favorites to each other. We know we can retell a familiar story even if we can't read all the words. During writing workshop, we learned how to stretch out the words slooowly while listening for each sound. We also discussed picturing the topic we want to write about, and putting all the details into the picture and words.

This Week in Math:

We practiced writing numbers zero through five. We learned simple rhymes that help us remember them like, "Around the tree, around the tree, that's the way to make a three." Practice counting objects around the house and writing the number of objects counted.

This Week in Science:

We continued learning about our five senses. We experimented with our sense of hearing and our sense of sight. We heard different sounds and guessed what they were (like a phone ringing or a fan moving air). We tried to go back to our seat from the rug without using our sense of sight. It was tough! We also took a five senses walk around our school grounds. We know we use all five senses to learn about the world.
