

This Week in ELA:

This week in reading, we talked about vowel Uu. Long Uu is one of the trickier ones, so extra practice at home might benefit your child. We also discussed blends "br" and "bl" at the beginning of words. We recognized high frequency words make and here, read and illustrated "I'm a Little Penguin," and met a hilarious penguin named Tacky in our read alouds. In writing, we kicked off a new unit of persuasive writing. We thought of problems in our world (stealing, littering, hurting others, etc.) and wrote about these problems. We talked about how our writing should convince others to care.

This Week in Math:

We began our addition unit and practiced number bonds to solve equations:



With these, we also wrote equations (2+4=6 OR 6=2+4).

This Week in Science/Social Studies:

In social studies, we talked about who Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. was and why he was so important. In science, we began our study of penguins, focusing mostly on Emperor Penguins. We will go to research in the media center next week!
