This Week in ELA:

This week in reading, we practiced recognizing, writing, and hearing letters Nn, Qq, and Rr. We read and illustrated the poem *Five Little Pumpkins*. Ask your child to recite it for you with our motions. We also learned sight words *am*, *at*, and *is*. We focused on identifying characters and setting in stories we read, and also discussed what happened in the beginning, middle and end of the story. In writing, we have continued to practice creating sentences to tell a story. This week, we even got new writing paper with lines for our sentences. We are becoming awesome authors!

This Week in Math:

We continued solidifying our instant recognition of numbers 0-10 when we see a dot arrangement. We have also been working on identifying which number or group of objects is more than, less than or equal to another group.

This Week in Science:

This week we began our unit on Fall. We created bubble maps to show what we already know, and we also spent time learning about what animals do in the fall. Ask your student what squirrels, geese, or bears do during this time of year!
