This Week in ELA:

This week in reading, we practiced recognizing, writing, and hearing the *th*, *sh*, and *ch* digraphs. We also reviewed recognizing and producing rhyming words. Our nursery rhyme this week was *Baa Baa Black Sheep*. Ask your child to act it out and recite it for you! We went over sight words *jump* and *said* and focused on retelling stories. In writing, we kicked off our informational writing unit! Your child is sharing his/her expert knowledge in everything from sports to dinosaurs and writing fabulous informational pieces. We look forward to learning more about this style of writing in the coming weeks!

This Week in Math:

We continued our discussion of 2-D shapes as we learned all about 3-D shapes. We learned a cube has six square faces, a cone has one circle face and the other end is pointed, a cylinder has two circle faces, and a sphere is a perfectly round shape.

This Week in Science/Social Studies:

We concluded our wood and paper study with an experiment with Ms. Duke (our NASA teacher). We got to make our own paper using toilet paper, water, a bottle, screens, and sponges.
