This Week in ELA:

This week in reading, we practiced recognizing, writing, and hearing letters Ww, Xx, Yy, and Zz. We also read and illustrated the poem *Little Boy Blue*. We learned sight words *run*, *play*, and *you*, reviewing all of our previous words. In writing, we celebrated another Author's Chair, as writers shared stories that spanned more than one page. We focused on having a beginning, middle, and end, as well as using a storyteller voice. They did a fabulous job! During the second quarter, we will be practicing informational writing in our workshop.

This Week in Math:

This week we practiced identifying and describing 2-D shapes. We learned that 2-D shapes are flat. As we described our shapes, we learned that: a circle has 1 continuous curved side, a square has 4 equal sides, a triangle has 3 sides, a rectangle has 4 sides and 4 corners (shaped like L's), and a hexagon has 6 sides.

This Week in Science:

This week we learned about Wood and Paper. We learned that wood comes from trees and can be used for many different things. We learned that paper also comes from trees! We are excited to make our own recycled paper next week!
