This Week in ELA:

This week in reading, we recognized high frequency words **come**, **funny**, and **look**, and we discussed special vowel blends ou/ow and oi/oy. We also reviewed adjectives and practiced describing certain nouns in different ways. We read the poem Children of the Rainbow and practiced vocabulary words "freedom" and "harmony." In writing, we continued working on persuasive letters. We made sure that we could read our writing when we were done and that we offered good solutions to our problems. Coming up soon...We Have a Dream: Persuasive Speeches!

This Week in Math:

In math, we practiced recognizing teen numbers as a group of ten and extra ones. We have used double ten frames to practice this concept. Students also practiced writing equations to represent teen numbers as a group of ten and some ones (for example: 15 = 10 + 5 or 10 + 1 = 11). Next week we will continue our work with teen numbers and practice writing story problems. We continue to sharpen our addition and subtraction skills using smaller numbers.

This Week in Science/Social Studies:

This week in Social Studies we wrapped up our discussion on citizenship/presidents by learning about important monuments. We read about the Liberty Bell and the Statue of Liberty. We know that *liberty* is the same as *freedom*. We also began our African American History unit and learned who Harriet Tubman was.
