#### This Week in ELA:

This week in reading, we recognized high frequency words what, not and help, and we discussed blends str and spr at the beginning of words. We started a new way of doing Reading Workshop in which we focus on important vocabulary and research skills. Students also have more choice in the activities they get to do. So far, it is going well! In writing, we continued our persuasive writing and had a mini-celebration of what we have learned so far with some Author's Chair time. Next week will be working on subtraction fluency.

In science we wrapped up our penguin unit! We learned the important vocabulary word "molting" and discussed how penguins have to lose their baby feathers before their adult ones grow in.
