This Week in ELA:

This week in reading, we practiced recognizing, writing, and hearing letters Hh, Ii, and Jj. We also read and illustrated the poem *One, Two, Buckle My Shoe*. We learned the new sight words *we*, *the*, and *see*. We focused on identifying characters in stories we read. In writing, we practiced different strategies for stretching words. We pretended to hold an invisible rubber band and slowly stretch the word to hear the sounds. We also got an alphabet phonics chart attached to our writing folder so we can get help with letters and sounds whenever we need to.

This Week in Math:

This week in math, we classified and counted objects. We talked about which group had more, less or the same. We continued our fluency practice to quickly recognize numbers 1 through 5 when looking at a group of dots.

This Week in Science:

We began our discussion of the five senses. We have learned what our senses help us do and the body parts we use in conjunction with each sense. Next week, we will conduct experiments to further explore the five senses!
