This week in reading, we practiced recognizing, identifying sounds for, and writing letters Nn, Oo, and Pp. We read and illustrated the poem Baa, Baa Black Sheep and learned sight words yes, no, and is. In writing workshop, we are learning to write stories across more than one page. We are continuing to stretch our words and record letters for the sounds we hear.

#### This Week in Math:

This week in math, we have practiced composing and decomposing the numbers 8 and 9. We have written number sentences such as 8=2+6 and used counters to express these number sentences in a more concrete way.

#### This Week in Social Studies:

This week in social studies, we had a brief study of community, citizenship, and rule following. We learned what being a good citizen means and even got "inducted" into our classroom community.
